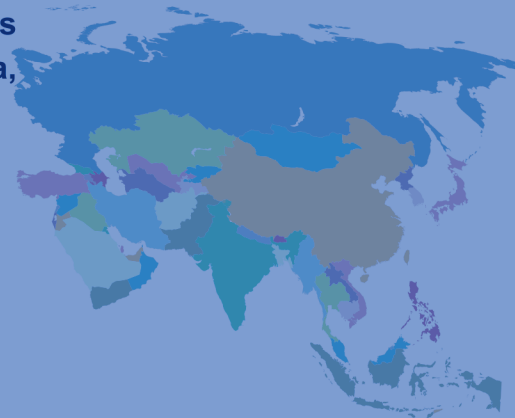


# INTRODUCTION TO ASIAN AMERICAN AND PACIFIC ISLANDER (AAPI)
