

What is Cinco de Mayo and why do we celebrate it?


Cinco de Mayo (5^{th} of May) is a holiday that celebrates the date of the Mexican Army's victory over France in 1862 in the Battle of Puebla during the Franco-Mexican War. It's a fairly minor holiday in Mexico, but in the United states it has developed into a large commemoration of Mexican heritage and culture.

This holiday is marked with parades, parties, mariachi music, Mexican folk dancing and traditional Mexican food, such as tacos and Mole Poblano. The largest celebrations are held in Chicago, Houston and Los


