Tip #4: Expand Your Definition of Learning

It is never too early to introduce children to **life skills** & encourage their application often. This helps them to feel like an important, contributing member of a group & fosters the development of a sense of responsibility for the household. There are appropriate chores for every developmental age-range: sorting & pairing socks (identifying pairs or sorting with similar items is a great way to practice spatial relations & symmetry); sweeping; making the bed are all developmentally appropriate for preschoolers & aid in developing both fine & gross motor skills along with cognition. Older kids can help prepare meals (measuring ingredients is a great way to explore proportions & fractions); wash & fold clothes; etc.

There are many every-day life skills that reinforce understanding of academic concepts. Once you begin to recognize that every experience is an opportunity for learning, & you demonstrate that to children, you will ignite the spark to build a lifelong passion for learning!

- Point at objects and name them (dog, cat, house)
- Talk back and forth with your baby
- Play games with them while you are reading
- Smile and answer your child's questions
- Encourage them to point at objects and name them
- Have them help turn the pages

- Ask them questions about the book
- Talk about the pictures and what the words mean
- Let them pick out the book they want to read
- Reward them and set goals for reading
- AGE 2-3
- Point out letters and numbers
- Look at pictures and make up stories about them
- Talk about the different characters
- Ask them their take on the story
- AGE 3-4
- Have your child tell the story
- Encourage writing and drawing
- Ask them the meaning of the story
- Have a conversation about what the words mean
