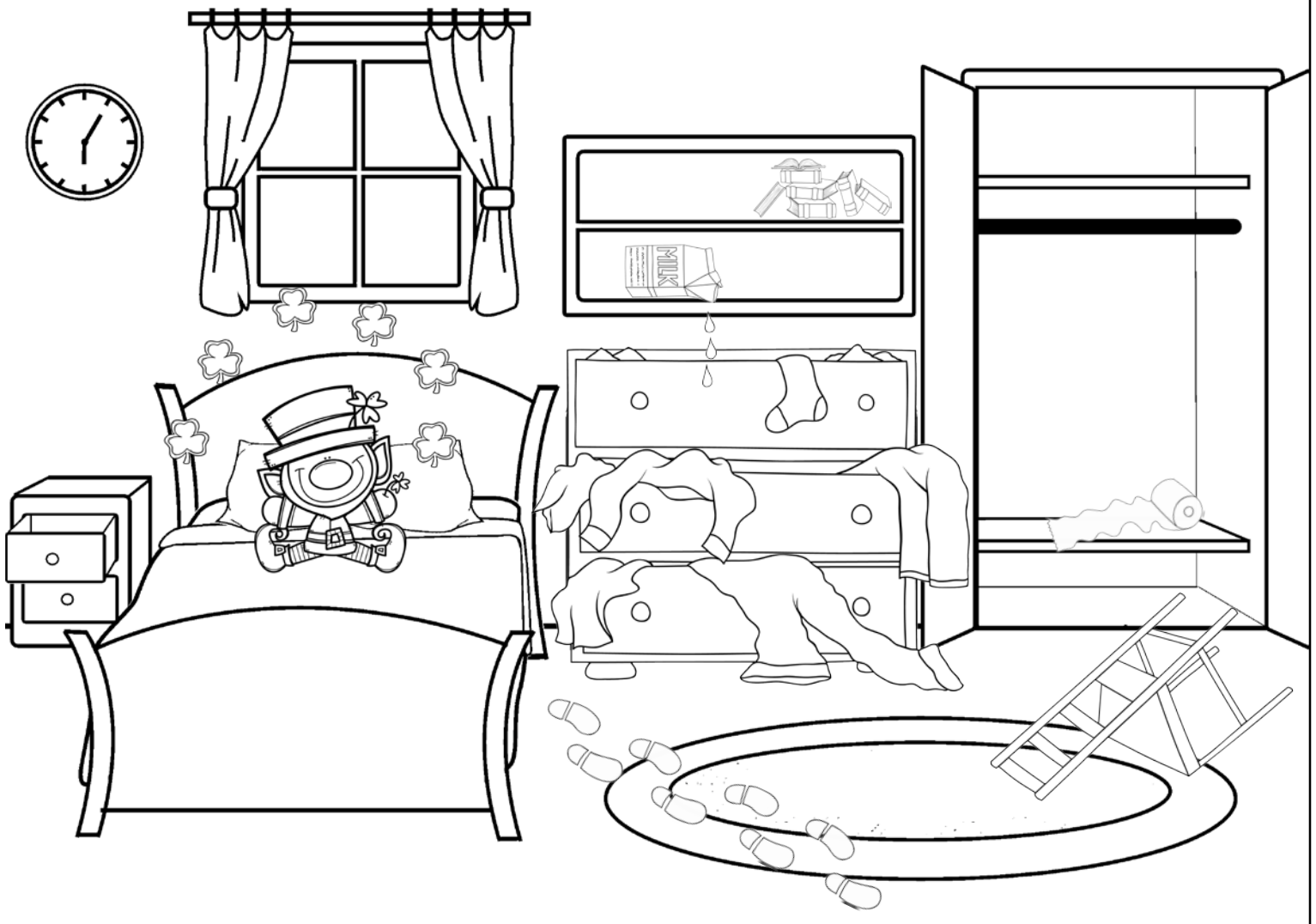


SEQUENCING
