Main Idea


Main Idea: On Memorial Day we honor and remember those who died serving our country.

ANSWER KEY

This page would be a great companion to a read aloud about Memorial Day. Students can write any details that they think support the main idea.

The main idea can vary on this page but should be along the lines of: There are many memorials that honor the men and women who died during times of war.

The path should go from the top, then left, then to the left again and finally down to the last box.

Possible additional details include:

- Wear red, white and blue.
 - Visit a national monument or museum.
- Volunteer to help veterans and the families of those who died during war.
- Fly the American flag at half-staff until noon.
